


Warm minimalism

A masterclass in warm minimalism

Your home is a place that represents you and how you wish to live. That's why it's always a joy to be invited inside our customers' homes, to discover the unique creative vision behind an interior.

If you have a vision for your home, discover our three tips to consider, as we learn more about Hali Mason and her interior.

- 1 Whether you're a minimalist or maximalist, take time to consider before investing in pieces of design for your home.
- "I have not always been a minimalist and so I can understand the difficulty in creating a minimal considered space. The best tip I can give people is to take time when considering each object they purchase for their home. I always try to select original pieces which are of good quality design and craftsmanship."
- "There are some objects which call out to you personally in some way. I am drawn to simple, pared-back designs that can make an impact on a room. I love it when you find an object that is on the cusp between subtle and statement too much and it can overpower a space, too little and it fades into the background."
- 2 Home should be a restful place that supports us both physically and mentally. For Hali, a minimal aesthetic supports her mental health. Storage, colour or comfort establish what additions would support you at home.
- "Home for me is not really the physical structure of the house I live in but rather the people and objects that surround me. It is the calm and welcoming feeling that a space evokes which makes me feel at home. A minimal aesthetic allows me to have every object I love on display and therefore I can appreciate them on a daily basis."

- "Living in a minimalistic space does wonders for your mental health. After a stressful day, there is nothing better than coming home to a calm and tranquil surrounding without too much visual noise. Lots of space and clear surfaces with a few select objects gives your mind room to breathe."
- 3 As your life evolves, so should your home.
 Create a more sustainable interior by investing in well-crafted pieces that will last a lifetime.
- "I would also encourage people to save for a piece of furniture or lighting that they can admire forever rather than buying mass-produced trendy products which can go out of style or are let down by their low quality. That way, although the initial spend is larger, the object becomes an investment for the future."

Design icon: Louis Poulsen PH 5

An icon of modernist design, few pieces of lighting have enjoyed the success of the Louis Poulsen PH 5. This distinctive silhouette can be found in homes, universities, and restaurants around the world – but what's the secret to its enduring popularity?

When the first incandescent lightbulbs started to appear in homes in the early 20th Century, Poul Henningsen was not happy with the unflattering light they provided. Determined to provide a solution, he dedicated years to experimenting with anti-glare shade systems, eventually developing the PH 5 in 1958 and changing the course of lighting design forever.



Poul Henningsen 1894 ~ 1967

The Danish master of light – <u>Poul Henningsen</u> was born in Copenhagen and studied architecture before immersing himself in the world of lighting design.

His collaboration with Louis Poulsen in 1924 sparked a lifelong relationship that resulted in designs such as the <u>PH Artichoke</u>, <u>PH 2/1</u> and of course the <u>PH 5</u>.

Henningsen's legacy continues to guide the work at Louis Poulsen today, with the human need for both darkness and light remaining the foundation of their lighting philosophy.

Designed to shape light

The PH 5 has a clever five-shade system that completely encases a lightbulb, reflecting and dispersing light to create a glare-free glow. Based on a logarithmic spiral, these shades direct the majority of light downwards rather than into people's eyes.

A sculptural mood-setter

True to Poul Henningsen's firm belief in a balance between form and function, the PH 5 serves as a beautiful sculptural centrepiece when both on and off.

Available in a classic 50cm diameter or the 30cm diameter of the PH 5 Mini – this beautiful pendant brings a dash of Danish elegance to wherever it's placed.

Have you ever wondered how the PH 5 got it's name? It's actually pretty simple – PH is for Poul Henningsen and 5 is for the 50cm diameter of the shade.

Be in the know

LED bulbs

Using up to 90% less energy than incandescent bulbs, LEDs are the most efficient form of illumination. They give a warm light and last the longest of any bulb on the market.

IP ratings

Ingress protection ratings measure the degree of protection a light source has against particles and water. Look out for ratings of IP44 or above for splash-proof bathroom or outdoor lighting, and IP65+ for the best protection against water. Some IP20 rated lights can be suitable for short-term use outdoors, but don't forget to bring them inside if it rains and at the end of the day.

Kelvins

This is how bulb colour temperature is measured. The higher the kelvin, the 'cooler' the light – 2,700 is a good value for residential interiors, and anything lower than this will provide a lovely 'warmer' light.



From plastic to PET yarn

Since its release in 2020, the ferm LIVING Desert Lounge Chair has quickly become a bestseller here at Nest, and it's not hard to see why. Sustainably crafted from 100% recycled post-consumer plastic, this chair has an interchangeable woven seat with a waterproof finish; making it perfectly adapted to indoor-outdoor living.

In order to make this recycled textile - discarded plastic is collected, crushed and compacted into solid blocks which can then be processed into soft fibres; ready to be spun into yarn. In an area known for its weaving heritage, expert craftsmen in the Indian state of Uttar Pradesh then transform this yarn into a beautiful textile which can be suspended from the Desert Chair's powdered steel frame.

The result is a soft and extremely durable textile that can be re-recycled at the end of it's life. What's not to love?

With so many options available, choosing the perfect rug can seem like a daunting task. From kilim to hand-knotted styles, let us help you find the perfect fit for your home.

Our top tip: define your needs

The first thing to consider when buying a new rug is what's going to work for you, your family, and your space. If your new rug is destined for the kitchen, stain resistance might be important; if it's in a sunny room, it might need to be protected against direct sunlight. If you have hard floors, a cosy, deep-pile rug can even help disguise noisy footsteps.

The quality of a rug is measured first and foremost by the material it's made of. Wool is the most popular choice and over 80% of our collection is made from this material. Wool rugs offer numerous advantages. Not only is it a natural fibre that offers comfort and warmth, it's also hard-wearing, fire resistant, dirt repellent and a sound insulator.

Understanding the terminology

Pile

This refers to the length of the fibre protruding from the base of the rug. As a general rule, the deeper the pile, the more luxurious your rug will feel.

Warp and weft

These are the threads used to form the base of the rug; the warp runs lengthwise, and the weft crosswise.

Hand-tufted

With the aid of a pistol-like device, lengths of wool are inserted into a cotton cloth base on which the pattern has been previously marked. Handtufting allows elaborate designs but not precise, curved ones.

Hand-knotted

A completely manual system in which the wool is strongly attached to the base by means of a knot. The value and durability of the rug increase with the number of knots.

Hand-loomed

This method uses a manually activated loom – a device which allows the insertion and extraction of rods that fix the height of the pile. Hand-loomed rugs are usually simple in design.

Kilim

This technique uses a manual loom to manufacture fabrics that mix bright, thin sections of colour to create distinctive geometric motifs. The result is a hair-free, hand-knotted fabric.





In conversation: Phil Cohen

Inspired by Scandinavian minimalism

After being drawn in by his expertly curated selection of designs, we couldn't wait to find out more about Phil Cohen and his style. An Art Director by day, Phil's considered eye stretches from his interiors to his clothing, with his minimal style really standing out from the crowd.

Your home has a very distinctive, minimal style – what inspires your look?

"I've long been inspired by Scandinavian minimalism and the design principles that surround it. I love the use of natural materials, pale colours and minimalistic shapes. It's contemporary yet timeless. This style isn't something you typically see here in the States, especially where I'm located."

When choosing timeless furniture for your home, what qualities do you look for?

"It's about buying less but buying better. Before I make a purchase, I ask myself if it's something that will add purpose to the house and my life or if it will just create clutter. Every piece of furniture should have its purpose and place. I value products that are created to last. Pieces that are crafted with thoughtfulness and care."

Achieving a considered, minimal style can sometimes be quite a challenge. Have you got any tips for people looking to create more minimal spaces?

- "Unless you're starting with an empty house, it can be a bit overwhelming. Clear the floor and walls, clean the surfaces, declutter and evaluate the space. Get rid of things that you don't need or haven't used in quite some time and then store the rest out of sight. If you don't have a lot of space to store things, then I would look into pieces that provide ample storage. Everything should have a place."
- "Pick subdued colours for the paint and neutral, earthy colours for furniture. A pop of colour here and there is certainly fine. Furniture selection should be intentional less is more. Think about what you can eliminate and still maintain comfort and enough seating to entertain family and friends."


